A summary of Healthwatch reports and publications

Between July 2020 and February 2021 Healthwatch Brighton and Hove published a number of reports, and undertook a range of activities, all of which can be found on our website. We have provided a summary of these below.

February 2021

Bulletins

• We published **four** Health and social care and COVID-19 bulletins, **five** COVID vaccination updates, and **one** other COVID-19 update.

Reports and press releases

- Dentistry. We issued a <u>press release</u> to highlight the crisis affecting dental services/. We also published an updated <u>public guide to seeing a dentist</u> at the current time.
- Interviews about remote appointments. In 2020, we undertook 106 phone
 interviews to explore people's opinions of accessing health and social care
 services during the pandemic. In December 2020 we interviewed some of
 these people Hear what they had to say about remote appointments.
- During the second lockdown in November- December 2020, Healthwatch in Sussex launched a 'Tell Us - Ask Us' campaign to encourage and support members of the public to Tell us about their experience of accessing health and care services and to ask us what they needed during this time. Media

- We sought your <u>questions and concerns about the COVID vaccination</u>
 <u>program</u> and shared these with a panel of experts from The British Society
 for Immunology.
- Our February care home webinar was picked up by Meridian news and we were able to facilitate an interview with a member of the public who had been affected by restrictions. This featured on the **news on 18**th **February**.

Survey

 We launched our survey to hear your thoughts and experiences about the vaccination programme in Brighton and Hove.

Advice and information

- We <u>published advice about registering with a GP</u>, stressing that here was no need to prove ID or immigration status, or provide an address.
- We published <u>COVID-19 Fact Check webpage</u> to help dispel vaccine myths and provide you with accurate information.

January 2021

Bulletins

This report looked at the different definitions of digital exclusion, why people are digitally excluded, why is it important, and its extent nationally and locally. - We updated our <u>patient guide to seeing a GP during the pandemic</u> and our <u>essential updates on local health and social care services in Brighton</u> <u>and Hove</u> and updated our <u>Frequently Asked Questions</u> document which we hope answers some of your questions about Covid-19 such as symptoms, treatment, self-isolating and links to additional guidance.

December 2020

Bulletins

 We published two Health and social care and COVID-19 bulletins, and four COVID vaccination bulletins. We also produced two special guides on meeting up over the Christmas period and accessing healthcare services during this time.

Reports

 We shared Healthwatch England's Dentistry report which examined the impact of COVID. Their findings about dentistry which followed widespread issues with access to NHS dental care as a result of COVID-19.

- We created a <u>dedicated webpage about services over Christmas and New Year</u>, and tips for staying over the winter.

- We promoted the <u>campaign to encourage people to get their flu jab</u> which was more important than ever.

- We released a <u>final report from the Healthwatch in Sussex public survey</u> on <u>digital consultations</u>, which was combined with results from the Sussex NHS Commissioners' survey on NHS communications with patients.

• In <u>an interview</u> David Liley, CEO explained the ongoing issues with track and trace, the availability of testing as well as the concerns about getting test results back.

- We promoted a new and free service created by <u>The Speak up Against</u> Cancer Team at Albion in the Community to help save lives.
- We also promoted the <u>Big Debate</u>. In response to the disproportionate of COVID-19 on ethnic minorities, the CCG worked with Diversity Resource International to host a series of webinars.
- We promoted <u>resources to help people with the mental health</u> during the pandemic.
- We published a <u>public guide to help people understand how to collect a prescription</u> for a friend, family member or neighbour.
- We shared information about <u>the launch of an enhanced NHS 111 service</u> from 1st October.

July 2020

Bulletins

We published four Health and social care and COVID-19 bulletins.

Reports

- We published a <u>performance report</u> describing Healthwatch Brighton and Hove activities from May to June 2020.
- We published the <u>outcomes from our Mental Health Sector Connector</u>
 <u>Forum</u> held on 8 July 2020. Sector Connector' is a Sussex wide
 collaboration between Healthwatch, the Voluntary and Community Sector
 and the NHS.



- The impact of COVID-19 on Brighton and Hove: a statistical evaluation. Since the coronavirus was recognised as a global pandemic, and particularly since lockdown was announced in England on 23 March, we have been presented with an ever-increasing amount of data describing the impacts of the virus (COVID-19). Our report brought together some key data and statistics for the public.
- We <u>published our Outpatients' booking systems: an interim Healthwatch</u> <u>report</u>. We launched an outpatients' booking survey in January 2020. By March, we had gathered the views of 120 patients but our plans to analyse the results, publish our report and discuss our findings with providers were halted by the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Environmental Audits of the Brighton and Sussex University Hospitals
 <u>Trust: a summary of our audit</u> work conducted between April 2019 to
 March 2020. We also produced our second report which examines the
 <u>outcomes from the annual Patient-Led Assessments of the Care</u>
 <u>Environment programme (PLACE).</u>
- We shared information about our <u>Healthwatch Wellbeing Discharge</u>
 <u>project</u> and our partnership working with Brighton and Hove City Council,
 Brighton and Sussex University Hospitals NHS Trust and the Sussex Health
 and Care Partnership.
- Publication of our GP Review report On 29th July, we published our
 review of all GP practices and surgeries across the City. Originally ready
 for publication in March just at the time when COVID-19 took hold in the
 UK we took advice from Healthwatch England, the City Council and the
 NHS and temporarily withheld publication of this report to facilitate the
 virus response.
