

Food - Telephone Shopping

Service	Overview	Contact Details and Christmas Operational Dates & Hours
Morrison's Doorstep Delivery	Morrison's Doorstep Delivery is a service you can call with your shopping list and place an order over the phone. When calling for the first time, you will need to create an account where a customer service advisor will take your personal details and your card details. Please do speak to the Customer Service Assistant for information on how your details are stored. You need to spend a minimum of £25 for delivery, but please note - if you spend under £40, you will be charged a 'Small Shop' fee on top of the delivery cost. Delivery is arranged by booking a time slot for when the shopping will come. Next day delivery may be possible but cannot be guaranteed, so it is a good idea to call a few days in advance of when you need a delivery to make sure your shopping comes for when you need it. The price for delivery will depend on the time of the slot and can range from £1.50 - £6. Ask the Customer Service Assistant to tell you the times and prices of available delivery slots	Tel: 0345 611 6111 - press option 5, then select - Option 1 - to set up account to use Doorstep Delivery Option 2 - if you already have an account and want to place and order Option 3 - for any other queries. Usual operating times - Order Mon-Sat 9am-5pm Christmas delivery slots are now open and are limited - order as soon as possible to book a slot for delivery near to Christmas Day -service closed 25th December and 1st of January.



Food - Telephone Shopping

Service	Overview	Contact Details and Christmas Operational Dates & Hours
Sainsbury's Assisted Shopping	Sainsbury's Assisted Shopping scheme helps older and vulnerable customers to place orders over the phone. When calling for the first time you will be asked to set up an account, including registering your bank details, you will then need to provide the last 4 digits of your long card number every time you call to make an order – please do speak to the Customer Service Assistant for information on how your details are stored. You need to spend a minimum of £25 for delivery, but please note - if you spend under £40, you will be charged £7 automatically for the delivery of your shopping. If spending more that £40, the price for delivery will be cheaper than £7, but will depend on what delivery slot you choose. Delivery is arranged by booking a time slot for when the shopping will come. Next day delivery may be possible but cannot be guaranteed, so it is a good idea to call a few days in advance of when you need a delivery to make sure your shopping comes for when you need it. The price for delivery will depend on the time of the slot. Ask the Customer Service Assistant to tell you the times and prices of available delivery slots.	O800 917 8557 press option 1 Usual operating times - Mon-Fri 9am-5pm. There are limited delivery slots available over the festive period. Food - Meal Delivery Services:

East Brighton Food Co-operative (EBFC)

The East Brighton Food Co-operative are a local volunteer led organisation who provide freshly home cooked meal deliveries to vulnerable people in Brighton and Hove. Delivery takes places on Tuesdays (3 meals per person) and Thursday (3 meals per person), deliveries also include soup, fresh fruit and dessert. You can choose to have meat or vegetarian meals delivered. Meals are stored in the fridge/freezer and then reheated when wanting to eat. This service costs £120 per month.

EBFC will also be doing an extra delivery this year on the 24th of December of Christmas Dinner for £12 per person.

EBFC normally have extra portions of meals prepared, so if you only manage to call them on the morning of a delivery day, they will always try to fit you in for a delivery that day. EBFC will be delivering as per their normal delivery schedule over the festive period.

Cookmere Foods

Cookmere Foods are a meal delivery service that deliver restaurant quality meals to your door daily. These meals can either be delivered hot, or chilled so that you can heat them at home. Your order can be a one-off just to cover the festive period, the only criteria is that the order is a minimum of £15 and you will need to set up an account with Cookmere. Payment for meals is taken by card over the phone when you order. Generally, you can start receiving Cookmere meals 48 hours after you set up an account with them, but for Christmas meals, please call to arrange this by **Monday 9th December**.

Food - Meal Delivery Services:

Oakhouse Foods:

Regular and reliable deliveries of frozen ready meals. There is an option to order groceries such as fresh food and cupboard items however it is a limited list of items available to select online and via brochure currently. Deliveries can be brought into your home on request. Payment by cash or cheque upon delivery possible or pay by card online or over the phone. Oakhouse Foods are offering frozen Christmas meals. Your order can be a one-off if the order is over £15. Free delivery on orders over £30, otherwise £1. You can get in contact with Oakhouse to receive their Festive Ready Meals brochure. Deliveries in Brighton and Hove happen on Tuesdays and Wednesdays (depending on where you live), if wanting a Christmas Meal delivered, you need to order by Monday 23rd December, for the last delivery which is the Tuesday 24th December. Oakhouse Foods will be closed and no deliveries will take place on 25th, 26th and 27th of December as well as New Years Day.

Over 300 delicious frozen ready meals and desserts, including gluten free and vegetarian options. Deliveries can be brought into your home on request. Payment by debit or credit card on the phone or online, or you can pay in cash or by cheque to your driver.

Wiltshire Farm are offering meals for Christmas. Your order can be a one off if the order is over £22. No delivery cost. The last delivery date before Christmas is 24th December, but it could be earlier than this depending on where you live in Brighton and Hove.

NHS & Care Volunteer Responders

NHS and Care Volunteer Responders is a flexible volunteering programme supporting the NHS and adult social care across England. The service is provided by the Royal Voluntary service and GoodSAM.

Support provided by this service includes -

Check In and Chat: A Check In and Chat Volunteer provides telephone support to people in need of a friendly phone call and encouragement to improve mental health and wellbeing. Check In and Chat Plus: This is a regular chat with the same volunteer over a 6-week period if you feel you are particularly vulnerable. This could be if you have been recently discharged from hospital, have a health condition, are experiencing social isolation or loneliness, have caring responsibilities or are waiting for elective surgery. Community Response: A volunteer will help with collecting prescriptions, lateral flow tests

Community Response: A volunteer will help with collecting prescriptions, lateral flow tests or shopping for those with a current health need.

Support depends on volunteer availability. If you call the NHS and Care Volunteer Responders phone line, the team are more than happy to talk through how the service works and answer any questions you have. Once you have self-referred, your request will be sent to local volunteers for them to sign up to help if they are available to.

Mental Health Support

UOK

UOK is a network of local community-based services working together to support good mental health and wellbeing in Brighton and Hove. Across Brighton and Hove, there is a range of mental health support available. They know that it can sometimes be difficult to find out information about services, know how to access them and know which ones are right for you. To help you navigate and access UOK services, they have a dedicated 'Central Access Point' team of Community Navigators to respond to your calls and emails. The Community Navigators are a friendly, caring bunch who understand that taking that first steps to make contact for support regarding your mental health can be challenging.

Sussex Mental Health Crisis Line

A mental health crisis is when someone feels at 'breaking point'. It can disrupt usual thought patterns, mood, daily activities, and feelings. People in crisis will usually need support quickly. The Mental Health Crisis Line is a 24/7 service that is free and available to everyone who is concerned about their own mental health or that of a relative, friend or someone they care for.

Call operators can offer general advice regarding managing mental health difficulties and suggest tools and coping strategies.
